TRAUMA AND VICTIM FOCUSED PSYCHOTHERAPY

Crimes have strong and lasting impact on victims. Sexual assault, domestic violence, sexual exploitation, assault, robbery and stalking harms victims and society alike. These crimes impact each victim differently, and care must be given to identify emotional as well as physical injury. The consequence of a crime may include a PTSD syndrome, fear of further injury, rejection by loved ones, shame, an acute stress reaction, loss of employment and loss of housing. An in-depth assessment of each client's needs and situation is required. Psychological treatment as well as referral to outside care-providers are often needed.

Minors who witness these crimes are also eligible for mental health services. Additionally, people who suffer a monetary loss because of death or injury to a crime victim may also be eligible for compensation.

These victims can include:

- Spouses or Domestic Partners
- Children
- Parents
- Legal Guardians
- Brothers
- Sisters
- Grandparents
- Grandchildren
- Undocumented Victims

TO MAKE A REFERRAL:

Victims of crime can be referred for services by calling 661-417-9432 or by filling out the referral information and faxing the that page to 661-418-2651. To be eligible, the crime must involve violence, threat of violence, hate crimes, human trafficking, online harassment or stalking. The crime must take place in California and the victim must be a resident. Proof of a crime is required (such as police report), protective order, hospital reports, etc.

Victims of Crime is funded through the State of California and was set up to allow citizens to obtain mental health and other services free of charge. You can get more information at:

WHO QUALIFIES FOR VICTIM COMPENSATION?

- Assault with a deadly weapon
- Battery (when there is injury or threat of injury)
- Child abuse/Elder Abuse
- Child sexual assault
- Child endangerment and abandonment
- Domestic violence
- Driving under the influence
- Hate Crimes
- Homicide
- Human Trafficking
- Hit and run/Vehicular manslaughter
- Murder
- Robbery
- Sexual assault/Sexual Battery
- Stalking
- Unlawful sexual intercourse (where there is injury or threat of injury)
- Terrorism
- Online Harassment
- Other crimes that result in physical injury or a threat of physical injury to the victim

INCLUDED IN SERVICES ARE:

- Help with Application process
- In-home Assessments
- Assessing the need for counseling
- Encouragement to increase overlapping social support networks
- Assessment for threat of self-harm
- Referral to a psychiatrist if needed
